Thuthukani Ndlovu is currently studying Honors degree in Marketing at the University of the Free State in Bloemfontein, South Africa, where he also is the Free State Literature Festival assistant. He has a passion for Marketing, Poetry and Social Activism and this is quite evident from the previous work he has done.

Apart from coordinating poetry events with the Free State literature festival, he has managed to perform in Lesotho, Zambia and South Africa (Cape Town and Johannesburg). He also hosted poetry workshops in Bloemfontein with the aim of equipping and inspiring upcoming poets.

He's the current creative director of The Radioactive Blog, a platform that has promoted a number of African fashion designers, Hip hop artists and poets over the past few years, and one of its key projects was a monthly digital publication of different anthologies throughout the year 2016. This project saw the blog work with over 100 poets from around the world, while publishing over 10 digital anthologies which had different themes.

To date, he has hosted workshops with the Free State Arts and Health (which was a build up to a show called "Spoken Words against Stigma" in 2017, and The Radioactive Poetry Workshops with the Adelaide Tambo Public Library. His latest project to date is "Giving Poetry Wings", which entailed a 2 day Hackathon with selected poets and digital artists, which later resulted in a digital art exhibition. This was hosted at the first Creativate Digital Arts festival - under the banner of the Grahamstown National Arts festival.
