Cris Gera is a Sweden based Zimbabwean singer who won the Swift Sing Our Song Competition which was held on Star FM Zimbabwe on the 25th of January 2013. Before the Swift Song Competition Cris did two albums and several performances on big events, clubs and restaurants in Zimbabwe. The musician is also an arts culture manager.

To date Cris has three full albums to his credit and three singles productions. His specialty is Afro Jazz and Afro Pop/Soul but he has also done part traditional Zimbabwean genres and even gospel productions. Cris has had excellent national airplay while still in Zimbabwe with his music played on all radio stations and also on Television. The musician has also had the privilege to share the stage and do collaborations with some of the region's elite in Africa's music fraternity.

Cris carries a passion for music that transforms people's lives. His goal has always been doing music for the people and use music to educate, preserve and present music as a communal and spiritual expression of life and diversity in the world. He seeks to create a nurturing environment that encourages cross-cultural exchange and celebrates the versatility of the human spirit.
