## Crack Theatre Festival – Australia



Morgan is a creative producer, theatremaker, and game developer based in Naarm (Melbourne), Australia. His practice as a producer centres on developing arts festivals and non-traditional theatrical performance, creating spaces that encourage artists to support each other as they develop their practice and new works.

As a theatremaker, he creates interactive works that draw from board- and roleplaying-games, using audience interaction and play to construct worlds and narratives that interrogate climate change and the way individuals and groups respond to disaster.

Morgan is a Producer for Crack Theatre Festival, an annual festival of live performance in Mulubinba (Newcastle), New South Wales, Australia.

He is also a producer-in-development through Next Wave Festival's Kickstart program, working to define a producing practice that prevents burnout for both himself and artists he works with.

He studied at the Australian National University, and trained at Canberra Youth Theatre as an Associate Producer and Playwright. He has previously been a Producer for YouAreHere, an experimental arts festival on Ngunnawal Country (Canberra), ACT, Australia.

Morgan is intensely interested in work that interrogates ever-worsening climate realities, that challenges capitalist narratives and power structures, and that helps men make positive change on both an individual and societal level.
