Kadri Soerunurk is a Coordinator at sound, new music organisation based in North East Scotland that organises the annual soundfestival, new music festival.

Born and raised in Estonia, Kadri moved to Aberdeen, Scotland, in 2010 to study Events Management at Robert Gordon University. She spent the 2012/13 academic year in Limerick, Republic of Ireland as part of Erasmus Study Abroad Programme. She graduated with a BA Honours Degree (2:1) in Events Management in 2014.

Having passion for arts, she knew before moving to Scotland that she wanted to work in the cultural sector. Alongside her studies, Kadri gained experience by volunteering at various charity events and festivals and working part-time at Belmont Filmhouse, local independent cinema. She first got involved with soundfestival in 2011 as a volunteer and successfully applied for the Coordinator role in 2015.

Her main duties as Coordinator at sound is to look after the administration within the organisation and coordinate all logistics and planning for the soundfestival and year-round programme of events and educational projects. This involves liaising with artists, venues, venue technicians, members of public, other festivals organisers etc and leading team of 30 volunteers during the festival. She received a nomination in the Regional Rising Star category of the 2016 Aberdeen City and Shire Tourism Awards.

When she's not running around with music stands across Aberdeen, Kadri enjoys playing roller derby (Granite City Roller Derby), attending concerts and theatre shows and baking banana breads.
