Then I became an assistant producer in Theatre Above, which established by a Taiwan playwright, who's now also famous in mainland China, most of productions we presented were trying to discuss cultural gap issue and human self-identity cognition.

I joined The A.S.K (Art Space For Kids) three years ago. At first I was a

tour manager and assistant producer. I worked with 20 art companies from 10 counties (most of them are European countries), touring to 16 different cities all around China under The A.S.K.'s nationwide tour network. Since this year I become a programmer and producer, programming for 6 A.S.K theatres in Beijing, Shanghai, Hangzhou, Nanjing, Foshan, and other 28 theatres in China we cooperate with.
